



BANK WIRE and ACH INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYMENTS TO BACPAC Genomics, Inc.

Please note that our bank (USBank, www.usbank.com) charges a fee for incoming international wires. It is also possible that your bank, or an intermediate bank, will add fees to the transfer. You (as the customer) are responsible for paying any wiring fees. Please request that your bank pays "in Full" to avoid any fees from your bank or intermediate banks to be deducted from the final payment. All wire payments will also be billed \$25 to cover the USBank fees normally added to international invoices. To avoid all bank-wire fees, please consider payment by credit card. Please include the reference "BACPAC" followed by the invoice number with all payments.

Payment by Bank Wire or ACH Transfer. Domestic and international wire transfers and ACH transfers are deposited to the BACPAC Genomics "USBank" checking account once they are processed by the Federal Reserve (domestic wires) or the Swift system (international wires). This is information senders of wire transfers will need to know:
